Summary of changes

This minor update to the About Me standard does not change the fundamental content of the standard or its 7 sections. The changes are to the information model and include:

- Amendments to element names, descriptions and implementation guidance to fix minor errors to follow PRSB style and modelling principles.
- Revision of the format of terminology artefacts (code system, code, set of codes, expression or set of expressions) as regular expressions to support simple string searches and validation of value sets.

Details of the changes

Element name

The name of the coded element in each of the 7 subsections has been changed as per the example below.

About Me response

Free text

Multi-media

Multi-media filename

Terminology binding

The format of the terminology binding in each of the 7 subsections has been changed to a regular expression as per the example below.

~~SNOMED CT ID | Fully specified name (FSN) 1515861000000103 | About me -- what is most important to me (record artifact) |~~

SNOMED_CT:"1515861000000103 |What is most important to me|"

These strings have the following format for pattern matching:

Prefix	Separator	Terminology artefact
SNOMED_CT	:	"SCTID UK preferred term "

Minor *errata*

The following types of minor content errors have been fixed:

- Incorrect use of capitalisation
- Grammatical error
- Incorrect formatting
- Spelling error or typo (without change of meaning)
- Incorrect description (with change of meaning)
- Description without a full stop
- Mid-sentence switch from second to third person
